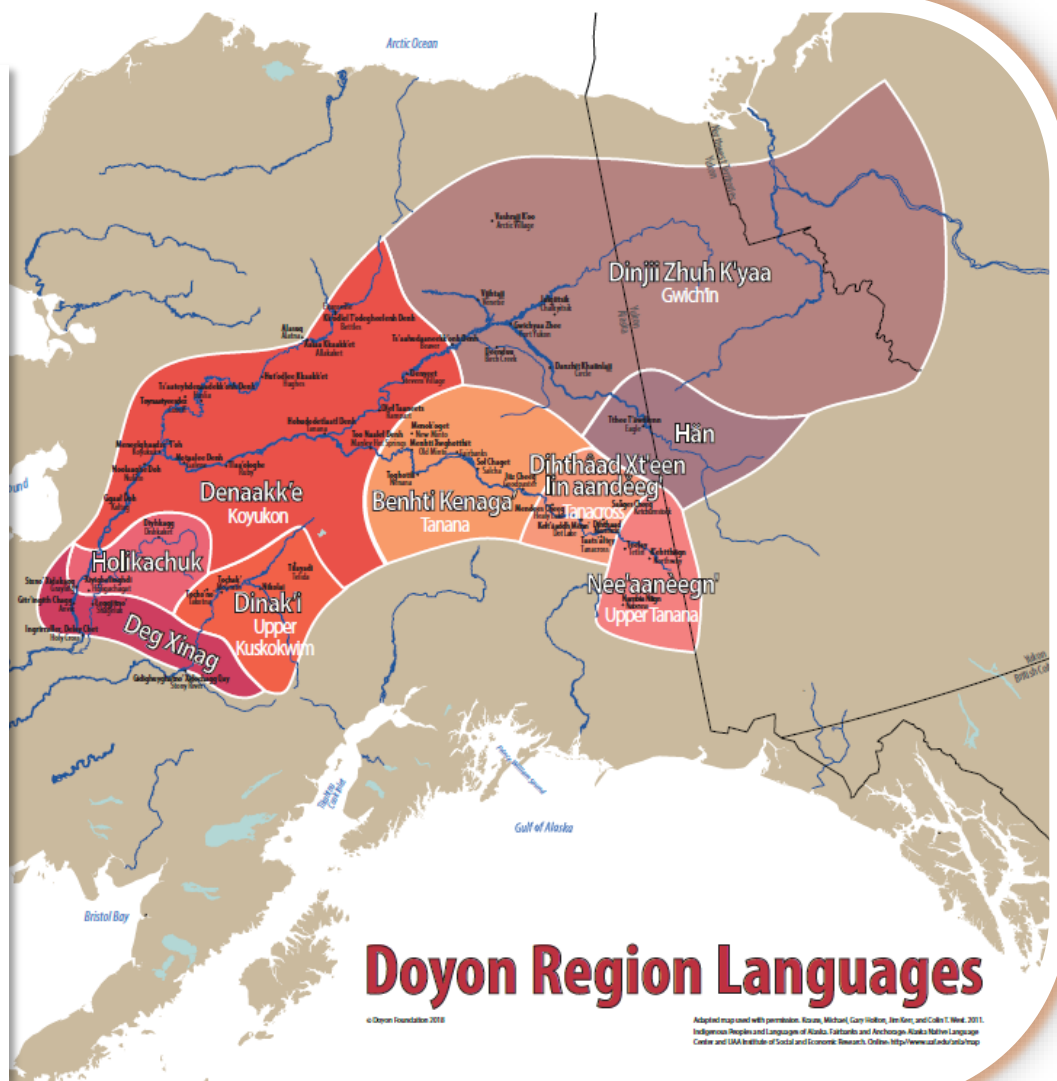
There are 10 different languages within the Doyon Region.

- ◇ Denaakk'e (Koyukon)
- ◇ Deg Xinag
- ◇ Benhti Kokhut'ana Kenaga (Lower Tanana)
- ◇ Holikachuk
- ◇ Inupiaq

Nine of these languages are severely to critically endangered.
